


Fig: Students of college and school are participating in Empowering Democracy Camp




Fig: The guest speaker gives lecture on importance of democracy







Fig: Student takes part in cleanliness initiatives




Fig: Guest Speaker giving Lecture on Women's Empowerment







Fig: Certificate for attending the Camp provided to students
