Report on Covid Awareness Program conducted by Vivek P.G. College, Kalwar

Date: 10.11.2020

Objectives:

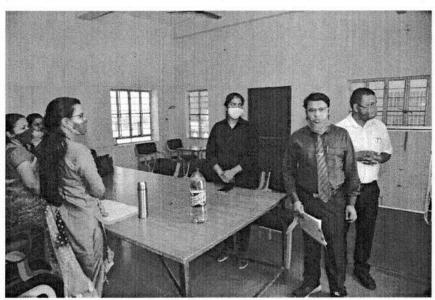


Fig: Health experts visit college for lecture on Covid-19 related issues

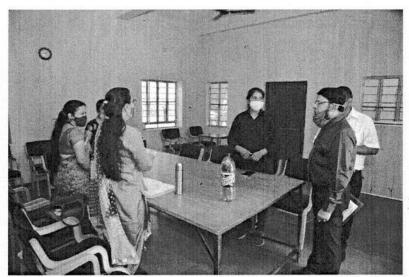
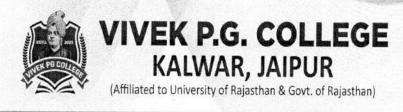


Fig: Health experts discussion with faculty members on Covid-19 related issues

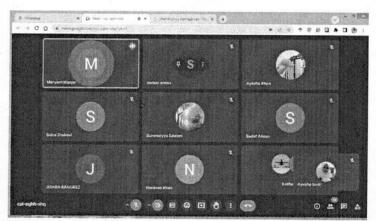


Fig: Screenshot of Google meet on Effective Presentation Skill

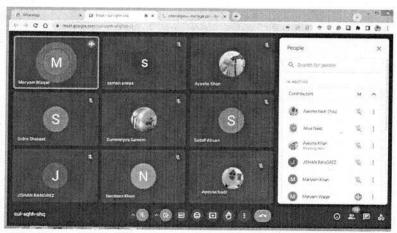


Fig: Screenshot of Google meet on Effective Presentation Skill
