## Report on Covid-19 Vaccination Camp conducted by Vivek P.G. College, Kalwar in collaboration with Pink City Blood Centre, Jaipur

Date: 15.12.21

## Objectives:

- To Facilitate Vaccination: Provide COVID-19 vaccinations to students, faculty, and local residents.
- To Promote Public Health: Support the broader public health campaign to achieve higher vaccination coverage.
- To Ensure Safety: Facilitate a safe and organized vaccination process with adherence to health guidelines.

## **Brief Report:**

The vaccination camp was set up in the college auditorium. Staff from Pink City Blood Centre, along with college volunteers, managed the registration desk and guided participants through the process. 

## Report on Mask Distribution Programme conducted by Vivek P.G. College, Kalwar






Fig: Students participating in cleanliness and plantation drive in NSS Camp in Gajadharpura




Fig: Students participating in rally








Fig: Students participating in blood donation camp




Fig: Students participating in blood donation camp




Fig: Guest lecture on Cancer Awareness and its initiatives






Fig: Students participating in activities in Scout and Guide Camp
