


Fig: A Staff encouraging students about menstrual hygiene management




Fig: Demonstration of Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine




Fig: Students participating in handicraft skills





Fig: Guest lecture in Seminar




Fig: Interactions with nearby tribal families on different social issues




Fig: Interactions with nearby tribal families on different social issues




Fig: Interactions with nearby tribal families on different social issues





Report on Ozone Day: Popularizing Ozone Protection conducted by Vivek P. G. College, Kalwar

Date: 16.09.23

Objectives:

- To educate the students and public about the importance of ozone layer protection and the harmful effects of ozone depletion
- encourage individuals, organization and government adopt practices that reduce ozone depleting substance and promote sustainable development

Brief Report:

A group of students and faculty members visited the Biological Park, where they had the opportunity to observe ongoing research related to ozone layer monitoring and protection. The visit included guided tours of the facility, demonstrations of scientific instruments used for ozone measurement, and discussions with researchers about their work on ozone depletion and recovery. The Zoology Head provided an in-depth overview of the science behind ozone layer depletion, its effects on climate and health, and the international agreements aimed at addressing the issue, such as the Montreal Protocol. The session included interactive elements such as Q&A and discussions on how individual actions can contribute to ozone protection. Participants engaged in a workshop that involved practical exercises related to environmental protection. Activities included creating models of the atmosphere to demonstrate how ozone depletion occurs, and developing campaigns to raise awareness about ozone-friendly practices. The workshop aimed to translate theoretical knowledge into practical actions and solutions. The day ended with a reflection and feedback session where participants shared their experiences and insights gained from the visit.

Outcomes:

- Greater awareness about the impact of ozone-depleting substances (ODS) and how everyday actions can affect the ozone layer.
- Increased adoption of practices and products that do not harm the ozone layer, such as
 using ozone-safe refrigerants and avoiding products with high levels of ODS.
- Strengthened collaboration between local governments, environmental organizations, schools, and the community to promote and implement ozone protection measures.



Volunteers from the college and the Gram Panchayat conducted outreach programs in different parts of Kalwar. A special interactive session was held for the youth, focusing on breaking myths and stigma associated with menstruation. Activities included role-playing, group discussions, and creative workshops to help young people feel more comfortable discussing and managing menstrual health. The day concluded with a feedback and reflection session where participants shared their experiences and provided input on the campaign. The session helped assess the impact of the campaign and gather suggestions for future initiatives.

Outcomes:

- The campaign successfully increased awareness about menstrual hygiene, with many participants reporting a better understanding of menstrual health.
- Feedback from participants indicated a high level of satisfaction with the workshops and resources provided.
- The distribution of menstrual hygiene products met a significant need in the community, particularly among those with limited access.
- The campaign fostered greater community engagement and encouraged ongoing discussions about menstrual health and hygiene.






Fig: Students participating in cleaning college campus




Fig: Writing skills was explained by the expert




Fig: Students participating in literacy program




Fig: Science Day celebration




Fig: Captain Swati Sharma felicitating the students




Fig: Students participating in blood donation camp




Fig: Community members participating in blood donation camp




Fig: Inaugural program of Seminar by remembering Kapoor Chandra Kulish




Fig: Speaker motivating students on World No Tobacco Day




Fig: Speaker motivating students on World No Tobacco Day






Fig: Students of NSS and Scout and Guidecleaning area nearby college
