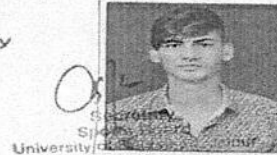

3. Similarly, by organizing parades where students develop and demonstrate discipline and dedication.

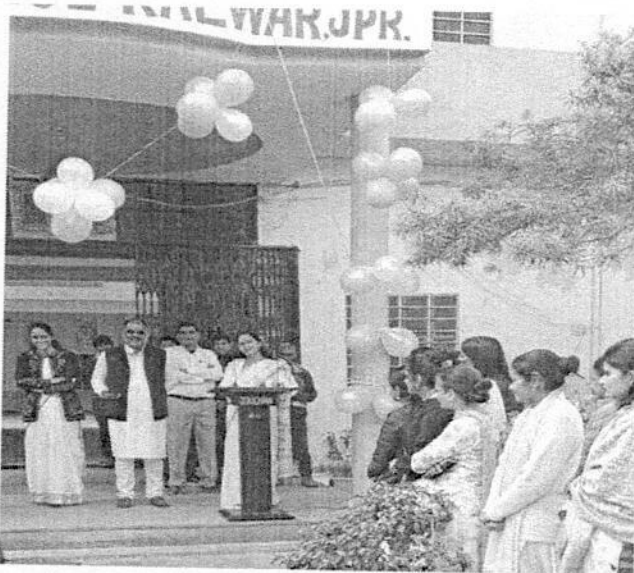

3. Eco-Friendly Initiatives A workshop on making eco-friendly Ganesh idols will also held. Students prepared beautiful hand-made dandiyas.

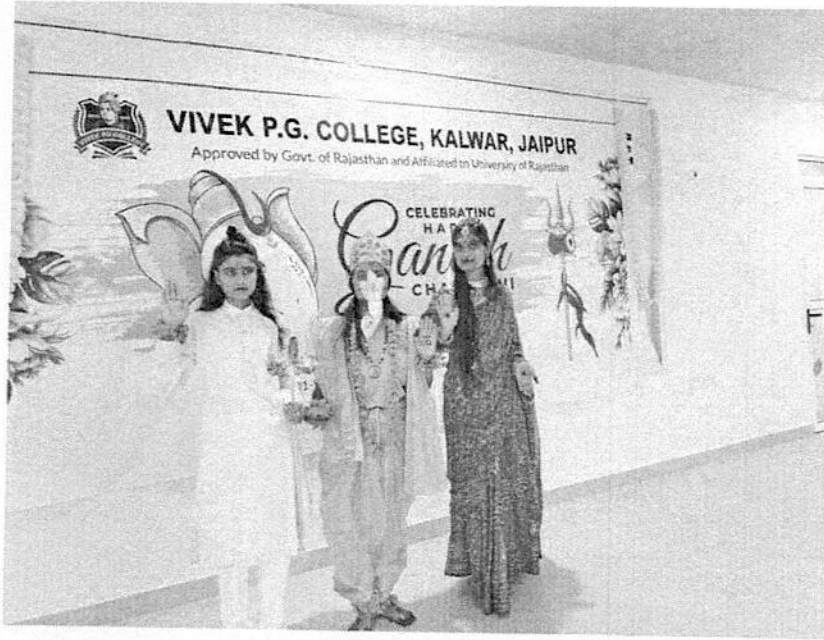

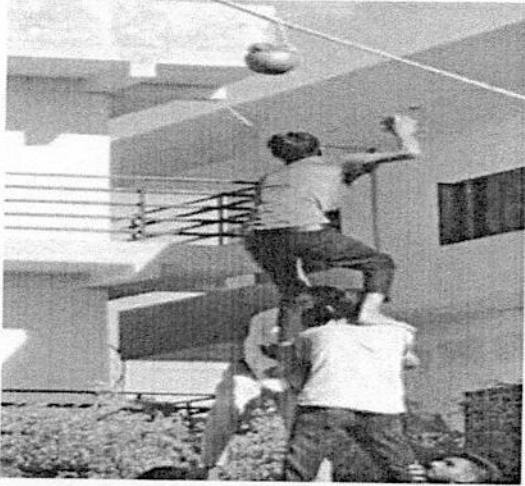

- Numerous cultural events, like dance performances, singing, and skits by freshmen and seniors, were arranged to enable newcomers to get to know one another.

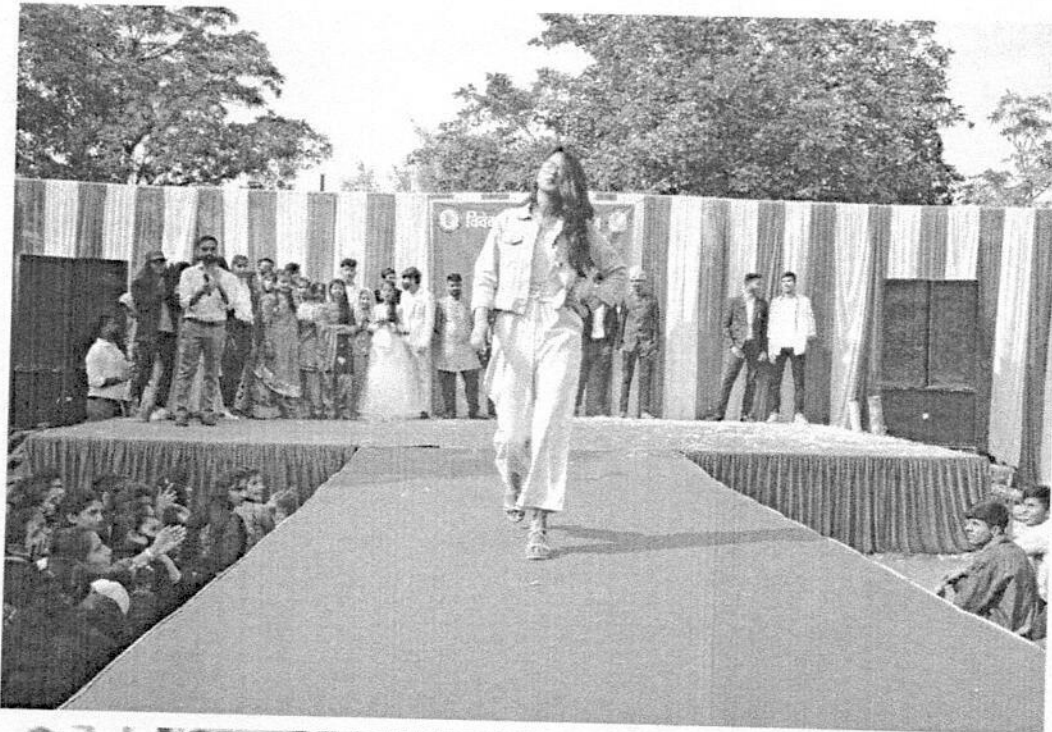


### Program:

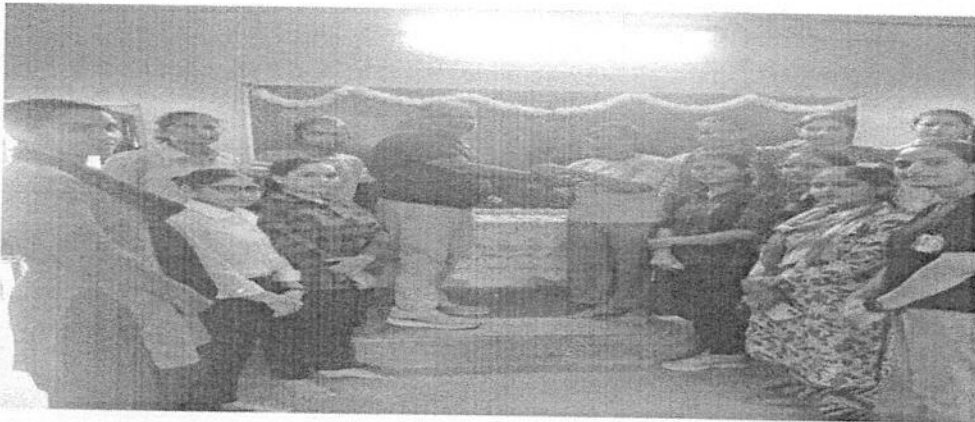

5. Such actions instill the importance of preserving and promoting character among students from an early age.


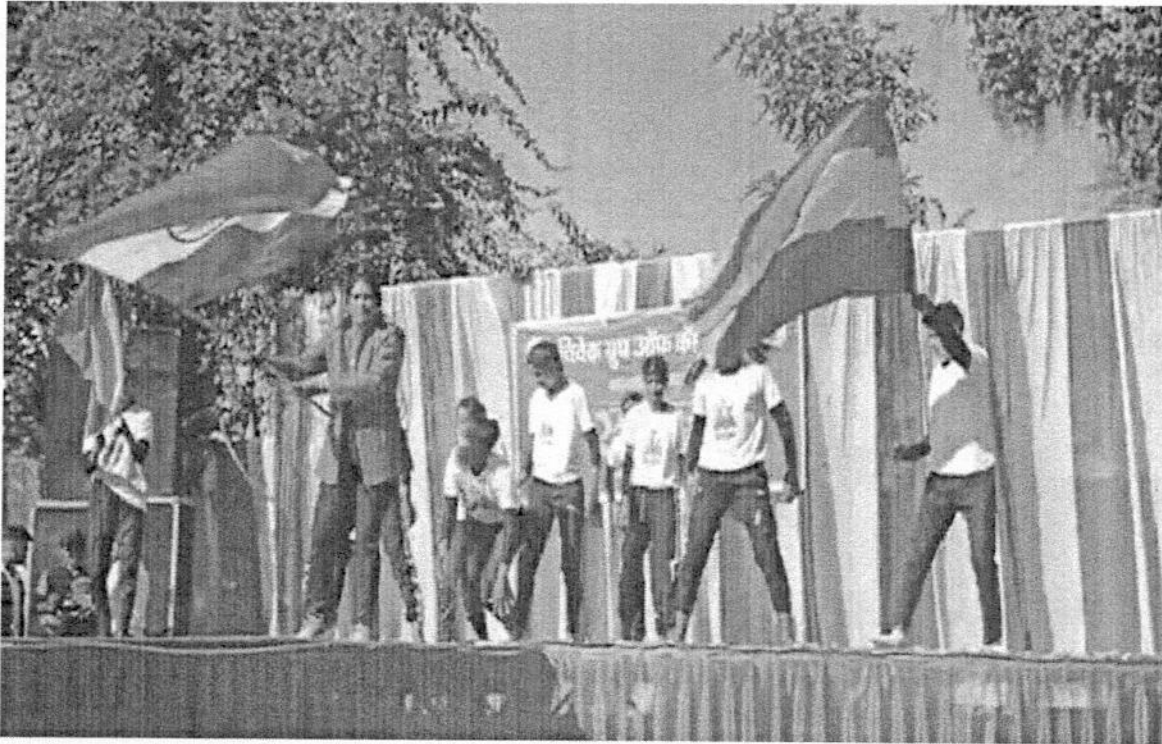
