

Report on Traffic Awareness Program conducted by Vivek P.G. College, Kalwar in collaboration with Manda Bhopawas Panchayat

Date: 18.01.2023

Venue: Vivek P G College, Kalwar, Jaipur

Objectives:

- To educate students and local community members about traffic rules, regulations, and the importance of road safety.
- To encourage the adoption of safe driving habits and responsible behavior on the roads.
- To contribute to the reduction of traffic-related accidents and fatalities by informing participants about the risks and preventive measures.

Brief Report:

The program commenced with an opening ceremony attended by college faculty, students, and local traffic authorities. Speeches were delivered by key figures, including the Principal of Vivek P.G. College and a local traffic officer, highlighting the importance of road safety and the objectives of the program. A workshop was conducted by traffic police officers focusing on key traffic rules, road signs, and regulations. Participants were educated about the legal aspects of traffic violations and the penalties associated with them. This session covered best practices for safe driving, including defensive driving techniques, the importance of seat belts, and the dangers of distracted driving (e.g., mobile phone use). 


Fig: Students attending lecture on Traffic Awareness Program




Fig: Lecture on Traffic Awareness Program




Fig: Students attending demonstration session on Traffic Awareness Program




Fig: Students attending demonstration session on Traffic Awareness Program








Fig: Demo of defense technique given by guest in Self Defense Workshop








Fig: Student attending seminar




Fig: Guest lecture in Seminar




Fig. Dr. Lata Parashar sharing insights on Bharat ka Savidhan: Kal, Aaj, Aur Kal during the seminar."




Fig: Students performing different Asanas of Yoga



Report on NSS Camp conducted by Government Sr. Sec. School, Gajadharpurain collaboration with Vivek P.G. College, Kalwar

Objectives:

Brief Report:




Fig: Students participating in cleanliness and plantation drive in NSS Camp in Gajadharpura
