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# Report on Tribal Day Celebration conducted by National Service Scheme (NSS), Vivek P.G. College, Kalwar

- · Empowerment of tribal youth through cultural expression and leadership opportunities



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

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Report on Ozone Day: Popularizing Ozone Protection conducted by Vivek P. G. College, Kalwar

## **Objectives:**

- To educate the students and public about the importance of ozone layer protection and the harmful effects of ozone depletion
- encourage individuals, organization and government adopt practices that reduce ozone depleting substance and promote sustainable development

## **Brief Report:**

A group of students and faculty members visited the Biological Park, where they had the opportunity to observe ongoing research related to ozone layer monitoring and protection. The visit included guided tours of the facility, demonstrations of scientific instruments used for ozone measurement, and discussions with researchers about their work on ozone depletion and recovery. The Zoology Head provided an in-depth overview of the science behind ozone layer depletion, its effects on climate and health, and the international agreements aimed at addressing the issue, such as the Montreal Protocol. The session included interactive elements such as Q&A and discussions on how individual actions can contribute to ozone protection. Participants engaged in a workshop that involved practical exercises related to environmental protection. Activities included creating models of the atmosphere to demonstrate how ozone depletion occurs, and developing campaigns to raise awareness about ozone-friendly practices. The workshop aimed to translate theoretical knowledge into practical actions and solutions. The day ended with a reflection and feedback session where participants shared their experiences and insights gained from the visit.

### **Outcomes:**

- Greater awareness about the impact of ozone-depleting substances (ODS) and how everyday actions can affect the ozone layer.
- Increased adoption of practices and products that do not harm the ozone layer, such as using ozone-safe refrigerants and avoiding products with high levels of ODS.
- Strengthened collaboration between local governments, environmental organizations, schools, and the community to promote and implement ozone protection measures.

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

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



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
