


Fig: Speaker motivating students on World No Tobacco Day




Fig: Speaker motivating students on World No Tobacco Day






Fig: Students participating in blood donation camp




Fig: Community members participating in blood donation camp




Fig: In-depth exploration of Digital Transformation in Banking: Opportunities & Challenges.








Fig. An enlightening session led by Dr. P S Yadav, discussing with an enthusiastic audience






Fig: Students cleaning area outside camp area
